



Registration Scam Alert

Members of the public and Prospective Students of Tshwane North TVET College are warned against the scam that is making rounds in the name of Tshwane North TVET College and its officials.

It has been brought to the attention of the college management that there is an imposter under the pretext of being an employee of Tshwane North College dealing with student's admissions.

The institution is aware that prospective **students** are promised admission in the college and are requested to **secure spaces** by paying an admission fee of **R500.00**

Please note that the college does NOT charge students an admission fee.

You are therefore warned to be in the lookout for suspicious email addresses including the following **Telephone Number:** (012) 372-5921 and Cellphone **Number:** 083 978 5107 which are unknown to the college.

If you receive suspicious Social Media inboxes, messages or calls from scammers posing as Tshwane North TVET College staff, please do NOT share your personal details, and or make any payments.

For the record, all official information from the college and registration processes are only done from assigned points in our campuses.

You are therefore advised not to continue with such conversations.
